1.1 UPS Specifications

District currently uses and would prefer Tripp Lite models. Looking for Tripp Lite Model SMART2200RMXLN or UPS with equivalent specifications.

- Maximum Output Capacity: 1800-2500 Watts with additional battery connection
- Nominal Output Voltage: 120 Volts
- Output Connections: NEMA 5-15 or NEMA 5-20 (Minimum of 4 outputs)
- Nominal Input Voltage: 120 Volts
- Input Connection: NEMA 5-15 or NEMA 5-20
- Cord length: A minimum of 8 ft.
- Battery type: Maintenance-free sealed lead-acid battery.
- Rack Mountable
- RJ45 network connection & SNMP/HTTP web interface

1.2 Extended Battery Specifications

- Must be compatible with current UPS Models which is Tripp Lite Model: SMART2200RMXLN

1.3 UPS Purpose

All uninterrupted power supplies will be use to support core and edge switches.

Nebraska City Public Schools may, at its discretion, choose to cancel its offer for the purchase of any and all goods or services requested in this proposal if E-Rate funding is not approved by USAC, there is a reduction in funding, there are changes in the physical structure of a school (i.e., renovations, demolitions), or for any reason.
